Il ritorno di un mito della Estetica e della Filosofia dell'Arte del '900 e d'oggi. In Elogio della disarmonia Gillo Dorfles vuole soprattutto precisare

l'importanza che ha riacquisito - o sta riacquistando - il pensiero mitico, l'immaginario, l'irrazionale e, in genere, tutto quanto si discosta dai canoni ormai consunti del simmetrico, dell'armonico, del logico. In particolare egli sottolinea alcuni aspetti del sempre più evidente predominio dell'Asimmetrico e del Disarmonico nella quotidianità e dà una nuova interpretazione all'antico problema della "confusione delle lingue" (eteroglossia), intesa non solo come rinnovato Mito di Babele, ma come giustificazione di molte recenti avventure in alcuni settori delle arti: dall'architettura al teatro, dalle arti visive a quelle della parola. Gillo Dorfles, critico d'arte e professore universitario di estetica, a partire dall'immediato dopoguerra si è impegnato in un'appassionata difesa dell'arte d'avanguardia, imponendosi in Europa e nelle Americhe come una delle personalità più attente agli sviluppi dell'arte e dell'estetica contemporanea. What are the dilemmas they create for our teaching at the end of the twentieth century? To all these questions, a wide range of scholars here tries to find answers. In thorough and highly original contributions, they not only address theoretical problems, but also engage themselves in practical analyses of specific works.
