Ted Bundy lived in the state of Utah from 1974-1975, and confessed to killing 8 women during that time, though authorities believe that number is closer to 11-14 out of the 18 serial killers' victims in the 1970's. Serial Killers' Psychology - Psychologenie Serial killers can be either prepared (organized), unprepared (disorganized) or a mix of both. Organized serial killers work out a crime in a methodical manner, like luring with ploys, abducting, killing and getting rid of the body (bodies) in a secluded place, all being a plot of a thought of plan.
